The Protégé

Protégés can be individuals new to the Training and Development industry, or experienced professionals looking to change the path of their career or learn new skills. To become a Protégé the following criteria must be met:

- Be an ATD member for at least three months
- Be willing to set and actively work toward achieving goals and/or learning objectives.

The Mentor

Mentors can be individuals looking for opportunities to give back to ATD, experienced professionals looking to sharpen their own skills as they teach others, or training professionals looking for renewed confidence and motivation to achieve their own goals. To be a Mentor the following criteria must be met:

- Be an ATD member for at least three months
- Ability to spend a minimum of one to two hours per month with Protégé between June and November to work with a Protégé toward achieving professional goals
